

# **INFORMATION - Emden Vaccination Center**

## How do I get an appointment at the vaccination center?

Appointments can only be made via the hotline 0800 99 88 665 or the state's online portal www.impfportal-niedersachsen.de .

It is not possible to make an appointment via the vaccination center or via the citizens' telephone service of the city of Emden.

### Who gets vaccinated and when?

The federal government has issued corona vaccination regulations that specify the order in which vaccinations are given. Read more at www.niedersachsen.de/coronavirus

#### Where is the vaccination center?

The vaccination center in Emden is located in the rear section of the Nordseehalle (Früchteburger Weg 17-19, 26721 Emden). Directions and access are via Sielweg and the parking lot there. You can take the bus free of charge to the vaccination center and back on the day of the vaccination. For this, you just need to show your invitation to the vaccination appointment.

## What do I need to bring to the vaccination?

Please bring your appointment notice, official proof of identity with a photo (e.g., ID card, passport, driver's license), and your vaccination card (if you have one).

If possible, please also bring the completed "Clarification Form" and the "Medical History and Consent Form" with you. If you do not bring these two documents, you can get them at the vaccination center. Volunteer vaccination assistants will be happy to help you fill out the forms. #### What is the vaccination procedure?

Please be sure to arrive on time for your appointment. You will only be admitted at the specified time. There is no covered waiting area in front of the center.

At the vaccination center, you will first be registered. For this purpose, you will need the documents mentioned above. Your temperature will also be taken.

At the second station, the documents will be checked and processed by staff members. Then you will go to the waiting room. After waiting for a short while, a doctor will ask you to come in for a consultation. You will be informed in detail about the vaccination and can ask questions.

If you and the doctor agree to the vaccination, you will go to one of the four vaccination booths. There, the vaccination will be administered in the upper arm. Afterwards, we will ask you to sit in the waiting area for about 15 minutes for observation. You will receive an appointment for the second vaccination at the vaccination center. Depending on the vaccine, this will take place at an interval of 3 to 12 weeks.
